FIRST ANNUAL SING-A-THON - SATURDAY, MAY 20TH & III &

Details for this event, including exact times and locations, are still being finalized. Stay tuned for more information in January or February. It will most likely be from noon-6:00 at Lars/Central Grade with specific blocks of time during that six hours for certain grades/classes to be in attendance to perform solos, duets, trios, quartets, and other small & large ensembles, as well as a few large choir performances. Most songs will be selected by students with teacher approval happening before spring break to allow for plenty of practice time. We are hoping to provide special lighting/effects and possibly even a live band to accompany students who are ready to perform this way instead of just using a karaoke track although that will also be an option. This will be a fundraising event with opportunities for students to solicit sponsorships for family, friends, and neighbors along with some paid advertisements from local businesses to help underwrite the costs involved - we might even have a few special guest performers and food available - it's gonna be a ton of FUN!!!


