

6th Grade Choirs will perform from 12:00-12:30 followed by about a dozen 6th grade soloists from around 12:30-1:30. 6th Grade students and families are welcome to stay or free to leave after the group performances are complete at around 12:30. Students remaining for the solo & small group portion of the event should have a parent present or at least one parent responsible for a small group of students. Additional adult volunteers will be at the doors and around the auditorium to help with any needs.

7th & 8th Grade: Arrive by 4:45

7th & 8th Grade Choirs will perform from 5:00-6:00 preceded by about 30 soloists and small ensembles from around 1:45-4:15. 7th & 8th Grade students and families are encouraged and welcome to arrive as early as they'd like to enjoy listening to and supporting the soloists. A detailed schedule of soloists will be provided within the next week or so.
