<u>Music Literacy</u> - One of the key components of developing outstanding musicians is music literacy. While Choir students certainly learn a lot through listening, the use of their sense of sight is also crucial! All students recently took a music literacy pre-test and we've been practicing identifying the following musical terms and concepts: <u>pitch letters</u> and <u>solfege syllables</u> on the treble clef and the bass clef, <u>rhythmic values</u> of notes and rests including dots and ties, <u>tempos</u>, <u>dynamics</u>, <u>articulations</u>, <u>piano notes</u>, <u>key signatures</u>, <u>intervals</u>, and more <u>music theory basics</u>! Check out some of the previous links to pages on the Choir website and have your student demonstrate how quickly they can successfully complete some of the speed challenges. You could also take the <u>music literacy pre-test</u> (requires a TCAPS student login) with them so they can demonstrate their knowledge!
